

What Do We Need to Know About Summer Burn Safety?



- Sunburn
- Heat Exhaustion
- Outdoor cooking and campfires
- Lightning
- Motor Vehicle Heat Safety
- Emergency Care



Sunburn First Aid



- Apply cool compresses or bathe burned area
- Take over-the-counter pain medicine as directed
- Drink extra fluids
- Use perfume-free, alcohol-free lotion



Heat Exhaustion



- Treatment
 - Lay person on back and raise feet
 - Loosen tight clothing
 - Seek medical attention



Charcoal Grill Safety



- Always keep a water supply or extinguisher nearby
- Extinguish coals with water
- Dispose of coals safely after thorough dousing: never bury hot coals in sand



Propane Gas Grill Precautions



- Check fuel connections
- Follow manufacturer's instructions when lighting
- Leave fuel valve shut (when not in use)
- Keep fire extinguisher nearby





Lightning Safety



- Seek
 - Vehicle (stay inside with windows closed)
 - Ditch, trench or low ground (except in heavy rain)
 - Group of shrubs or trees of uniform height
- Squat, kneel or sit, don't lie flat
- Cover ears with hands



Motor Vehicle Heat Safety



- Never leave a child or pet alone in a vehicle
- Keep car doors locked
- Put sun shades in front and back windows
- Beware of hot surfaces (seat belt buckles, vinyl seats)





Emergency Care for Burns



- Stop the burning process
- Run cool water over burned area
- Remove all clothing from the burned area
- Cover with a clean dry cloth
- Call 9-1-1



Emergency Care for Burns



Electrical burns

- Do not approach victim until you are sure power is turned off

Chemical burns

- Flush affected area with running water for at least 20 minutes
- If the area is still painful, continue to flush until pain stops



Housing Demolition



- Approvals have been received, and funding sent to the Corps of Engineers for demolition.



- All remaining houses in West Wherry have been identified to be demolished.



- Remaining residents will be required to relocate **No Later Than 15 September 2016.**
- Contractor personnel will move at their own expense.
- Government personnel may be moved at Government expense.



- **Two bedroom housing units in East Wherry are extremely scarce.**



Housing - Yards



Yards should be maintained to present an esthetic beauty and to assist in preventing rodent infestations.



Grass should be cut and leaves raked and disposed of.



Lawns must be watered in order to prevent grass from dying.

The Self-Help store has various items to help you maintain your yard, to include many new lawn mowers.



Pets



Pet dogs continue to be a problem. Dogs are roaming freely throughout the housing area. Some have attacked other smaller dogs. Please remember, Pet dogs are to be kept on a leash (not to exceed 15 feet in length) and under the owner's supervision and control at all times when outside of the home or fenced-in yard.



Pit Bulls, American Staffordshire Bull Terriers, English Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Rottweilers, Doberman Pinschers, Chows, wolf hybrids, and crosses of these breeds are generally classified as dangerous breeds and are not allowed in Dugway Proving Ground Family Housing.



Pets (Con't)



- Residents are reminded that they are financially liable for all damage caused by their pets to doors, floors, carpets, walls, shades and blinds, screens, appliances, cabinets, and outside structures.



- Poop and scoop is mandatory and requires the removal of all pet waste from yards and common areas (including the dog park).



- All dogs and cats over the age of 90 days must be immunized and wear a current rabies tag.


IMCOM OPORD 16-086: IMCOM Enterprise Restructure/Transformation



- IMCOM will reshape and reorganize to meet approved FY19 TDA levels.
- Transformation includes realigning Atlantic and Central Regions into three (3) IMCOM Support Directorates (ISD)
- ISD will be co-located with Army Commands
 - US Army Forces Command (FORSCOM)
 - US Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC)
 - US Army Material Command (AMC)
- Mission complete when IMCOM HQ, IMCOM garrisons, and ISDs are reorganized with Full Operational Capability (FOC) NLT 30 Sep 18.
